**PLEASE READ THESE REQUIREMENTS THOROUGHLY**

**WE ARE ASKING YOU TO...**

- **RSVP by Thursday morning** of the week you will attend worship via email or by calling the church. You will need to do this every week!
- **Arrive between 8:35am and 8:55am.** We appreciate your patience!
- **No congregational singing.**
- **Keep 6 feet distance** upon entering and exiting.
- **Enter only through the doors near the Coffee Bar**, on the W. Bel Air Ave. side of the building. Only those needing handicapped accessibility (*wheelchair or cannot do steps*) will be allowed to use the Nursery School entrance.
- **Wear a mask at ALL times indoors.** *Note: Worship leaders will not wear masks when leading.*
- **Follow instructions** from our trained ushers and greeters.
- **Follow ushers** to an assigned designated seating area in the Sanctuary.
- **No contact** (handshakes, hugs, etc.) with anyone (we know this is hard!).
- **Stay home** if you are feeling sick or have a cough or other symptoms.
- **Remain in your seat** at the end of worship until ushers dismiss row by row.
- **File outside** before socializing, if you wish.

**BEFORE COMING TO CHURCH, ASK YOURSELF THESE QUESTIONS...**

If any are answered "YES," we ask that you stay home and utilize our online service:

- Am I currently experiencing, or have I experienced in the past 14 days, any of the following symptoms: Fever, Shortness of breath, Cough, Loss of taste or smell?
- In the past 14 days, have I been in close proximity to anyone who was experiencing any of the above symptoms or who has tested positive for Covid-19?
- Am I a healthcare worker that has been within 6 ft. of a patient suspected or confirmed to have Covid-19, without personal protective equipment?

## COMMON QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

### **Will pew cushions and Bibles be available?**

No. You are welcome to bring your own and make sure you take it home with you each Sunday.

### **Will we do the handshake/passing-of-the-peace?**

No. We are asking that there be no direct contact.

### **Will we pass the offering plates?**

No. There are two offering boxes located in the narthex or you can continue to give online or mail checks to the church.

### **How will we receive Communion?**

On Communion Sundays, there will be individual pre-package Communion elements placed in the pews for you to participate in the Communion Service.

### **How long will the service be?**

It will be approximately an hour or less in length.

### **Will online services still be available?**

Yes! Our livestream will continue each week on YouTube and Facebook.

### **Will we be meeting indoors/in-person every Sunday?**

The hope is that we will. We will continue to monitor the state, county, and city Covid-19 rates and make decisions accordingly. If things change, we reserve the right to cancel in-person worship.

### **What about the kids?**

There will be no in-person Sunday School or Childcare provided no "Busy Boxes". Children should remain with their families in worship. We are currently working on providing virtual Sunday School for our children and youth, to be offered online in the near future.

### **Will ministry teams and groups be able to meet in-person?**

No. We are taking this process one step at a time. We will continue to monitor and evaluate further openings. To be clear, the Sanctuary space will be the only area to be used each week. We will share updates when this change.

Please know, we understand that many people will still feel uncomfortable or unable to attend indoor Sunday worship services. You should not feel badly about that! Each one of us has our reasons for the precautions we are taking in order to stay healthy.
